¹ **Definition:** A child of an employee, of an employee's spouse or of both, or a child living with the employee for whom adoption procedures have been undertaken, unmarried and living or domiciled in Canada, who depends on the employee for his financial support and who is under eighteen (18) years of age: every child under twenty-five (25) years of age who is a duly registered student attending a recognized learning institution **on a full time basis** or a child of any age who became totally disabled before reaching his eighteenth (18th) birthday or before his twenty-fifth (25th) birthday, if he was a duly registered student attending a recognized learning institution on a full time basis and has remained continuously disabled ever since.
