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# Contex

Netagamiou School distinguishes itself with a unique set-up where a Francophone and an Anglophone school coexist within the same building. Both the school and the community encourage and value bilingualism. The school offers preschool education, elementary and secondary instruction to 9 girls and 21 boys. The school also houses a Community Learning Center, Adult Education Services, and the Municipal Library.

Elementary and K5 instruction is offered in French and English, K4 education, and secondary instruction in English only. In secondary 4 and 5, some of our students come from 2 neighbouring communities and live in a student's residence, away from their family.

The staff is very caring with the students and puts in great effort to ensure their wellbeing. Despite this, we are preoccupied with the results of a recent survey revealing that only a minority of students expressed being happy in school, liking to read, and being interested in class activities. A second survey highlighted another area of concern regarding secondary girls' self-esteem.

The staff is highly dedicated to student success. However, the organization in multi-level and multi-subject classrooms brings many challenges. Students of different ages have different needs and interests which staff must consider daily in their interventions, pedagogical approaches, and classroom management strategies.

Our priority for the next four years is to maintain high levels of student success. To achieve this, we will focus on best practices in multi-level, multi-subject classrooms and pedagogical approaches that foster student interest in classroom activities and reading while encouraging positive self-esteem.
